



Solutions for bathtub and shower tray installation Compliant with DIN 18534

Application: bathtub






A minimum lap of 50 mm is required at tape and fitting connections. Laps must be properly bonded with Sopro RMK 818 to ensure a waterproof seal.





DIN 18534 "Waterproofing for indoor applications" requires due attention to be given in the waterproofing concept to the bathtub and shower tray base area.

The incorporation of sealing tape, adhesive-fixed around the bathtub or shower tray edge, represents one option. The waterproof membrane applied to the wall and screed is then carried up to and connected with this. This ensures watertight integration of the bathtub or shower tray in the membrane.











Application: raised shower tray

Where sheet membranes are specified, then the joints must be bonded with a minimum lap of 50 mm using Sopro RMK 818 Racofix® universal adhesive.

General application guidelines

- Remove any dirt, contamination, grease or adhesionimpairing substances from bathtub/shower tray edge
- Provide markings for bathtub/shower tray at place of installation so as to ensure accurate positioning and bonding of fittings in comfortable working posture
- Cut sealing tape to size, allowing for minimum laps of 50 mm at bonded joints
- After fixing tape and fittings to bathtub/shower tray edge, turn these inwards and temporarily secure with adhesive tape up to time of definitive fixing
- After bathtub/shower tray installation, watertightly bond laps using Sopro RMK 818 Racofix[®] universal adhesive
- Embed tape and fittings in Sopro waterproof membrane and then overcoat with two coats
